## Application for Equivalence of the Doctor's Degree

In relation to competitions for filling positions of Doctor Professor, at the time of

application, the candidate must present proof that he or she holds a doctor's degree granted by the USP, recognized by it or valid nationally (Art. 133, item II of USP's General Regulations).

If you have done your PhD abroad:

Prior to registration for the competition and with enough time to process the procedure, you must: either request the "equivalence of the doctor's title" or the "revalidation of the doctor's degree". READ CAREFULLY ABOUT WHAT EACH OF THESE MEANS REQUESTS.

"Equivalence of the title of doctor" The equivalence of the doctor's title will be valid exclusively within the scope of USP, for competitions within the USP.

Necessary documentation to request Equivalence of the Title of Doctor next to the Graduate Programs at the Institute of Chemistry:

- 1 Letter requesting the equivalence of a Doctor's degree;
- 2 Copy of doctoral transcript

(Note: if you have not attended courses in the Doctorate, you must attach document from the institution about the course processes);

- 3 Copy of the doctoral diploma;
- 4 Copy of the thesis;
- 5 Copy of the passport;

## Request for Revalidation of the Doctor's Title
